Bob founded and ran Bucklesham Football Team and paid for their kit, he could often be seen cutting the grass on the playing field, or spending hours maintaining the Church yard and Village Hall gardens. Together they donate their time to host the Plough Day, making it the huge success it is, raising thousands of pounds annually which benefits St Mary's Church and the Suffolk Horse Society.
