As current Chair of Bucklesham Parish Council, and on behalf of the Council I would like to welcome you to the village of Bucklesham. The Playing Field is held in trust and managed by the Parish Council with the help of a group of volunteers called the FOPs (Friends of the Playing Field) who manage the field for the benefit of us all. There are many footpaths in Bucklesham, some leading to neighbouring villages, and many through beautiful farms and woodland. We are very lucky to have the fantastic asset of St Mary's Church and the excellent Church community who work tirelessly for the village in so many ways.

The Parish Council holds meetings every two months (on the first Wednesday) and any resident is very welcome to attend.
